## FAITH FORMATION

People have a deep desire to know where they came from. Genealogy is a rapidly growing business, with websites such as MyHeritage numbering approximately 80 million members, and sites such as Ancestry.com are as common to some as Google and Yahoo are to others. DNA testing has also become more affordable and popular. People are willing to spend on the average between \$1,000 and \$18,000, all to answer the question: what is my story? What was my family like? Who were they?

God's chosen people, the Israelites, were a nation who treasured their past. They remembered every year their deliverance from Egypt by God through the celebration of the Passover. The stones in the Jordan River reminded them of the miracle God did in stopping up the waters so the people could cross into the promised land. The Old Testament was collected so that people would not forget who they were and what their story was.

You and I, and our families, have a great story too. Catholics have a history going back two thousand years, built upon the foundations of our Israelite forefathers. We have so many things to be proud of, that our Catholic ancestors have been a part of, as well as many examples of things to learn from. Our story begins in the New Testament, and specifically in the book of the Acts of the Apostles. How well do we know our story? How about our children? It's a thrilling book, relating how Christianity began with a handful of men and women, regular people just like you and me, and how they spread Jesus' message to the whole world. If you read two chapters a day starting today you will cover all twenty-eight chapters. Why is reading the Acts of the Apostles in the next two weeks important? Well, there are fourteen days from May 6th to May 20th, and on May 20th we celebrate the Feast of Pentecost, the birthday of the Church with the pouring out of the Holy Spirit. What better way to celebrate this important event than by taking five minutes of our busy day as a family to read OUR history! Spoilers: Pentecost takes place in chapter two!

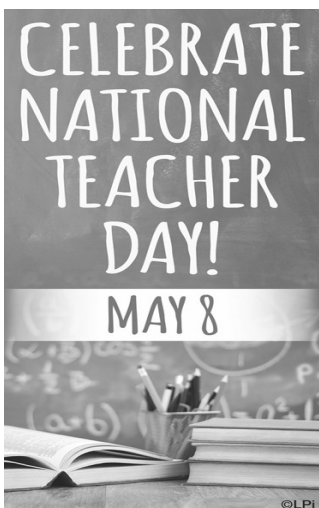

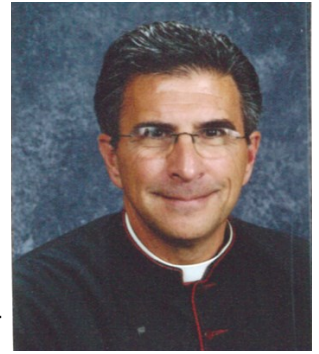
