With the success of our first summer youth retreat on prayer it has been discerned that our parish youth from ages 9-13 could benefit from another short retreat in July! This retreat will be on Saturday afternoon, July 21 and it will be on SCRIPTURE. Exact times are soon to be determined, but it will be three hours or under. 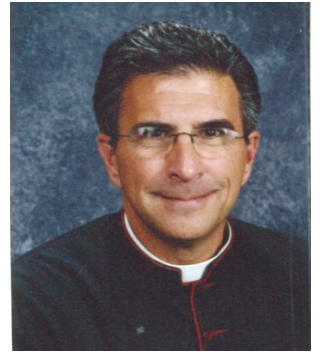
