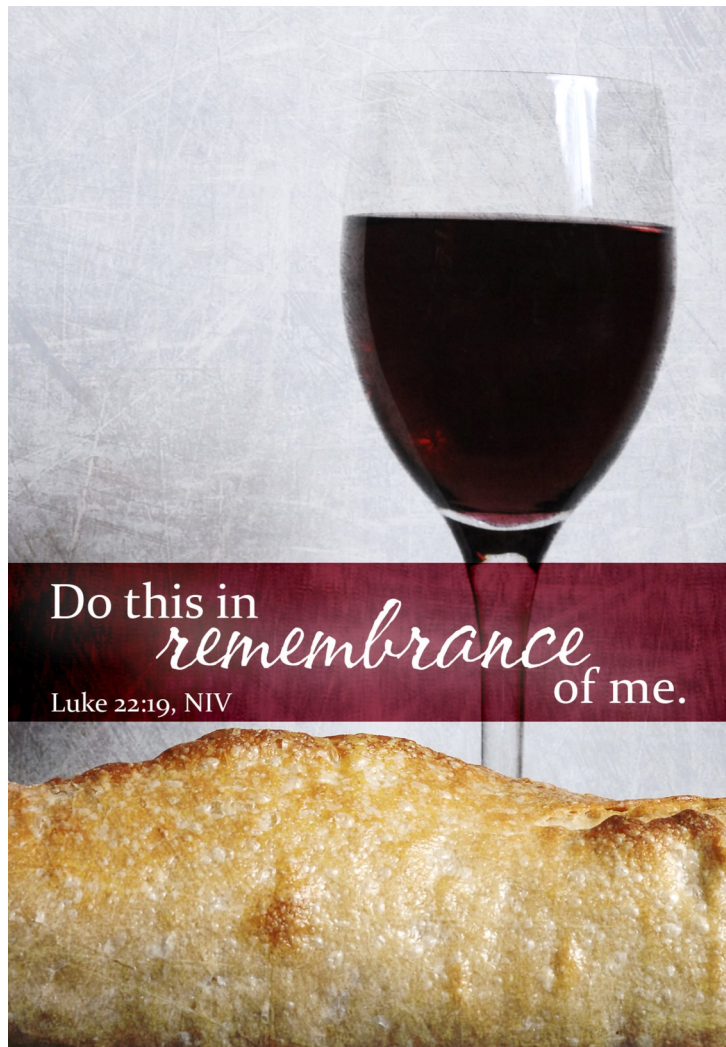

NAMI Family-to-Family Educational Program is a FREE 12 week course for families of individuals with severe brain disorders (mental illnesses). The course is taught by a trained family. All course materials are furnished at no cost to you. The curriculum focuses on schizophrenia, bipolar disorder (manic depression), clinical depression, panic disorder, and obsessive-compulsive disorder (OCD). The course discusses the clinical treatments of these illnesses and teaches the knowledge and skills that family members need to cope more effectively.
