

I am looking forward to this Sunday! We will be celebrating life and "God has a monopoly on life." As we learned last week, Jesus offers life and offers an abundant life to anyone who trusts in Him! Jesus proclaimed He is the resurrection and the life.

Did you know every sermon recorded in Acts discusses the resurrection of Jesus? The book of Romans is regarded as the most important piece of literature in history and is often referenced as the most significant book ever written. In the opening verses of Romans, Paul states that Jesus "was declared to be the Son of God in power... by his resurrection from the dead" (Romans 1:4). To the Philippians Paul said, "I want you to know Christ and experience the mighty power that raised him from the dead" (Philippians 3:10).
