On Resurrection Day, commonly known as Easter, there are so many delightful things to see. What impact will He make in your daily decisions? See Him as your risen Lord who is the Alpha and Omegathe Beginning and the End of all things; our Mediator-the Redeemer who brings forgiven sinners into the presence of God. 




