




COMMENTS TO FINANCIALS

A message from the Executive Director

Dear Vine Maple Place Partner,

We envision a time when there are no homeless families in this community, and we are committed to helping more and more families until that end is achieved. 2013 was a groundbreaking year for us as we piloted our new Stable Families program and <u>doubled</u> the number of families we served.

You were a key part of that progress. More than any other lesson, we've learned that ending homelessness can't be done by one agency. It takes a community. Each partnership we build increases the impact that we, as a community, can make. Together, we have the power to change lives – to bring hope and light and laughter back to families who have lost all those things.

Thank you for walking beside the families we serve. You are transforming the lives of parents and children by literally stopping homelessness in its tracks. Cindy* came to Vine Maple Place after she was laid off from the job she had held for 11 years. She had received an eviction notice and was making plans to move herself and her son into her car. She applied and was accepted into the Stable Families program, where her housing situation was immediately stabilized. She was able to avoid eviction and homelessness, and is now thriving in a job that pays a livable wage and full benefits. The lives of Cindy and her son were changed because you cared enough to offer her a hand up.

The strong backing we get from committed supporters like you, along with conservative management, has kept us financially stable and in a position to help more families like Cindy's than ever before. Of course, with growth comes challenges. We need more meeting and training facilities to serve more families, and helping more families also requires more financial resources. Your continued support will leave us poised to achieve our vision of *every* child and parent in the community having a safe, stable home in which to grow and thrive.
