Matthew 14:14 - And Jesus went forth, and saw a great multitude, and **was moved with compassion toward them, and he healed their sick.** KJV

Matthew 20:29-34 - Now as they went out of Jericho, a great multitude followed Him. And behold, **two blind men sitting by the road**, when they heard that Jesus was passing by, cried out, saying, "**Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!**" Then the multitude warned them that they should be quiet; but they cried out all the more, saying, "**Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!**" So Jesus stood still and called them, and said, "What do you want Me to do for you?" They said to Him, "**Lord, that our eyes may be opened.**" So **Jesus had compassion and touched their eyes. And immediately their eyes received sight**, and they followed Him. NKJV

Mark 5:1-20 - Then they came to the other side of the sea, to the country of the Gadarenes. And when He had come out of the boat, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit, who had his dwelling among the tombs; and no one could bind him, not even with chains, because he had often been bound with shackles and chains. And the chains had been pulled apart by him, and the shackles broken in pieces; neither could anyone tame him. And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones. When he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him. And he cried out with a loud voice and said, "What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me." For He said to him, "Come out of the man, unclean spirit!" Then He asked him, "What is your name?" And he answered, saying, "My name is Legion; for we are many." Also he begged Him earnestly that He would not send them out of the country. Now a large herd of swine was feeding there near the mountains. So all the demons begged Him, saying, "Send us to the swine, that we may enter them." And at once Jesus gave them permission. Then the unclean spirits went out and entered the swine (there were about two thousand); and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and drowned in the sea. So those who fed the swine fled, and they told it in the city and in the country. And they went out to see what it was that had happened. Then they came to Jesus, and saw the one who had been demon-possessed and had the legion, sitting and clothed and in his right mind. And they were afraid. And those who saw it told them how it happened to him who had been demon-possessed, and about the swine. Then they began to plead with Him to depart from their region. And when He got into the boat, he who had been demon-possessed begged Him that he might be with Him. However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, "**Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you.**" And he departed and began to proclaim in Decapolis all that Jesus had done for him; and all marveled. NKJV

So Ahab went up to eat and drink. **And Elijah went up to the top of Carmel;** then **he bowed down on the ground, and put his face between his knees,** and said to his servant, "Go up now, look toward the sea." So he went up and looked, and said, "**There is nothing.**" **And seven times he said, "Go again."** Then it came to pass **the seventh time, that he said, "There is a cloud, as small as a man's hand, rising out of the sea!"** So he said, "Go up, say to Ahab, 'Prepare your chariot, and go down before the rain stops you.'" Now it happened in the meantime that the sky became black with clouds and wind, and there was a heavy rain. So Ahab rode away and went to Jezreel. Then the hand of the LORD came upon Elijah; and he girded up his loins and ran ahead of Ahab to the entrance of Jezreel. NKJV
