## The Feasts of the Lord

### Part 4

October 21, 2020

**Introduction** - We are continuing our Bible Study on the **Feasts of the Lord**. So far we have studied six Feasts of the Lord: Sabbath, Passover, First Fruits, Unleavened Bread, Pentecost & Trumpets. If you missed any of these teachings, you could go back and watch the Teachings on our website or on our Facebook Page.

Tonight, we are going to Discover two more Feasts, **The Day of Atonement**, and **The Feast of Tabernacles**. We have been looking at the **Forecast** and **Fulfillment** of these Feasts in scripture. God desires that we study His feasts, not to bring us back into the Old Testament, but rather to help us grasp all that God has done for us through His Son Jesus Christ and how He desires to impart unto us, His Blessing.

As we study the Forecast and Fulfillment of the Feasts of the Lord it will simply strengthen our spiritual Foundation. Many Christians think the Feasts of the Lord are just Old Testament rules and regulations that people under the law had to keep. However, God never wastes anything; He uses the things He concealed (shadows) in the Old Testament, to now Reveal the fulfillment (substance) in the New Testament.

**Colossians 2:17** - Such [things] are only the **shadow** of things that are to come, and they have only a symbolic value. But the reality (the **substance**, the solid fact of what is foreshadowed, the body of it) **belongs to Christ**. AMP

#### I. The Day of Atonement/\_\_\_\_\_

##### A. Old Testament \_\_\_\_\_

**Leviticus 23:26-32** - And the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: "Also **the tenth day of this seventh month** shall be **the Day of Atonement**. It shall be a holy convocation for you; you shall afflict your souls, and offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. And you shall do no work on that same day, for it is **the Day of Atonement, to make atonement for you before the LORD your God**. For any person who is not afflicted in soul on that same day **shall be cut off from his people**. And any person who does any work on that same day, **that person I will destroy from among his people**. You shall do no manner of work; it shall be a statute forever throughout your

generations in all your dwellings. It shall be to you **a sabbath of solemn rest, and you shall afflict your souls;** on the ninth day of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath." NKJV

**Numbers 29:7-11** - 'On the tenth day of this seventh month you shall have a holy convocation. You shall afflict your souls; you shall not do any work. You shall present a burnt offering to the LORD as a sweet aroma: one young bull, one ram, and seven lambs in their first year. Be sure they are without blemish. Their grain offering shall be of fine flour mixed with oil: three-tenths of an ephah for the bull, two-tenths for the one ram, and one-tenth for each of the seven lambs; also one kid of the goats as a sin offering, besides the sin offering for atonement, the regular burnt offering with its grain offering, and their drink offerings. NKJV

**C. New Testament \_\_\_\_\_**

**Hebrews 9:11-14** - But Christ came as High Priest of the good things to come, with the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made with hands, that is, not of this creation. **Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.** For if the blood of bulls and goats and the ashes of a heifer, sprinkling the unclean, sanctifies for the purifying of the flesh, **how much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered Himself without spot to God, cleanse your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?** NKJV

**Hebrews 10:1 -14** - For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, and not the very image of the things, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect. For then would they not have ceased to be offered? For the worshipers, once purified, would have had no more consciousness of sins. **But in those sacrifices there is a reminder of sins every year. For it is not possible that the blood of bulls and goats could take away sins.** Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire, But a body You have prepared for Me. In burnt offerings and sacrifices for sin You had no pleasure. Then I said, 'Behold, I have come — In the volume of the book it is written of Me — To do Your will, O God.'" Previously saying, "Sacrifice and offering, burnt offerings, and offerings for sin You did not desire, nor had pleasure in them" (which are offered according to the law), then He said, "Behold, I have come to do Your will, O God." **He takes away the first that He may establish the**

**second.** By that will **we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.** And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But this Man, **after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God,** from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool. **For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.** NKJV

## II. The Feast of \_\_\_\_\_

### A. Old Testament \_\_\_\_\_

**Leviticus 23:33-44** - Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, saying: 'The fifteenth day of this seventh month shall be **the Feast of Tabernacles** for seven days to the LORD. **On the first day there shall be a holy convocation. You shall do no customary work on it.** For **seven days you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD.** On the **eighth day you shall have a holy convocation,** and you shall offer an offering made by fire to the LORD. It is a sacred assembly, and you shall do no customary work on it. **'These are the feasts of the LORD** which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, to offer an offering made by fire to the LORD, a burnt offering and a grain offering, a sacrifice and drink offerings, everything on its day — besides the Sabbaths of the LORD, besides your gifts, besides all your vows, and besides all your freewill offerings which you give to the LORD. 'Also on the fifteenth day of the seventh month, when you have gathered in the fruit of the land, **you shall keep the feast of the LORD for seven days;** on the first day there shall be a sabbath-rest, and on the eighth day a sabbath-rest. And you shall take for yourselves on the first day the fruit of beautiful trees, branches of palm trees, the boughs of leafy trees, and willows of the brook; and **you shall rejoice before the LORD your God for seven days.** You shall keep it as a feast to the LORD for seven days in the year. **It shall be a statute forever in your generations.** You shall celebrate it in the seventh month. **You shall dwell in booths for seven days.** All who are native Israelites shall dwell in booths, that your generations may know that I made the children of Israel dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt: I am the LORD your God.'" So Moses declared to the children of Israel the feasts of the LORD. NKJV

**Deuteronomy 16:13-17** - "You shall observe **the Feast of Tabernacles** seven days, when you have gathered from your threshing floor and from your winepress. And **you shall rejoice in your feast, you and your son and your daughter, your male servant and your female servant and the Levite, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow, who are within your gates.** Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the LORD your God in the place which the LORD chooses, **because the LORD your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you surely rejoice.** "Three times a year all your males shall appear before the LORD your God in the place which He chooses: at the **Feast of Unleavened Bread,** at the **Feast of Weeks,** and at the **Feast of Tabernacles;** and **they shall not appear before the LORD empty-handed. Every man shall give as he is able, according to the blessing of the LORD your God which He has given you.** NKJV

**Revelation 19:1-10** - After these things I heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, saying, "Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power belong to the Lord our God! **For true and righteous are His judgments, because He has judged the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication; and He has avenged on her the blood of His servants shed by her.**" Again they said, "Alleluia! Her smoke rises up forever and ever!" And the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God who sat on the throne, saying, "Amen! Alleluia!" Then a voice came from the throne, saying, "Praise our God, all you His servants and those who fear Him, both small and great!" And I heard, as it were, the voice of a great multitude, as the sound of many waters and as the sound of mighty thunderings, saying, "Alleluia! For the Lord God Omnipotent reigns! **Let us be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come, and His wife has made herself ready.**" And to her it was granted to be arrayed in fine linen, clean and bright, for the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints. Then he said to me, "**Write: 'Blessed are those who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb!'**" And he said to me, "These are the true sayings of God." And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See that you do not do that! I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy." NKJV

**Exodus 23:14-16** - "Three times you shall keep a feast to Me in the year: You shall keep the **Feast of Unleavened Bread/Passover** (you shall eat unleavened bread seven days, as I commanded you, at the time appointed in the month of Abib, for in it you came out of Egypt; none shall appear before Me empty); and the **Feast of Harvest/Pentecost**, the firstfruits of your labors which you have sown in the field; and **the Feast of Ingathering/Tabernacles** at the end of the year, when you have gathered in the fruit of your labors from the field. NKJV

**Revelation 19:11-16** - Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And **He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war.** His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. **And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses.** Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. **And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron.** He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: NKJV

**Conclusion** - On the **Day of Atonement**, we see the Awesome Responsibility Jesus had as the Perfect Sacrifice and Great High Priest. Our Faith in Christs Finished Work and our life Yielded to Him, not only Prepares us for the **Rapture**, secures our Reservation at the **Feast of Tabernacles/Marriage Supper** and gets our **White Horse**.
