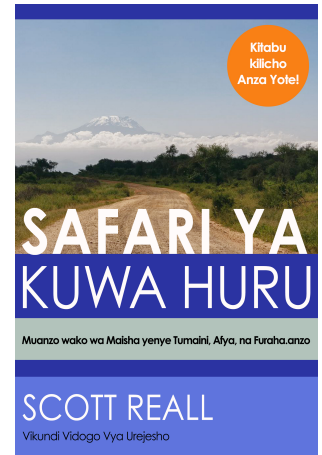


Why Africa? Why Now?

God is on the move! It's a truth that is echoed by all our staff, and the volunteers coordinating Restore's inaugural trip to Kenya, Africa. We see God moving as he brought key relationships to Restore—like that of Dr. Anna Edgeston, an American citizen, born of a Kenyan mother, and missionary father, whose heart burns to bring tools for spiritual, emotional, and mental wholeness to Kenya. We then met Dr. Robert Kamau, and heard his desire to share the Journey to Freedom process with the network of pastors that he mentors through his nonprofit, we knew there was no coincidence.

Journey to Freedom has been in Kenya for over 7 years, thanks largely to global small groups advocate, Stephanie Gibson and her contacts in Nairobi. Over the years Journey to Freedom has grown in the hands of a few key volunteers, growing slowly, with emphasis on impacting pastors. With a Swahili translation in the final phase, we envision Journey to Freedom being a new tool that can bring hope and reconciliation to the entire region. We have leaders signed up from youth organizations, YMCAs, churches, and community agencies, all to come and hear more about the Journey, and how they can build a healing community.

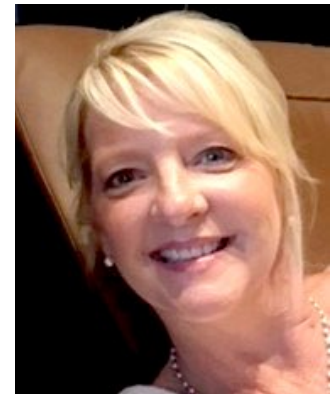


