

P2P (PASTOR TO PEOPLE) -PIGAPALOOZA PURPOSE

As I begin to get my head around our annual PigaPalooza ministry I am beginning to realize how God is using this church wide effort for furthering God's kingdom. The following are three ways smoking pork butts is helping to accomplish kingdom work:

- 1. **Serving others** The bottom line is that many people are served by our work to smoke pig butts. Remember Jesus Christ came not to be served by to give his life as a ransom for many. Serving others is at the heart of the gospel. Let me name a few ways this is service to others.
 - a. Because we smoke close to 600 pork butts we are **providing many meals** to help feed families, friends, and neighbors. This frees up those who buy them to **fellowship** with others over a meal or during a game like the Super bowl. Guess what someone might say after trying a pork butt bought from GP? Where did you get this amazing meat?
 - b. By buying close to 600 pork butts we are serving the meat provider who use this income to support an employee, a farmer (who raises the pig), a family who relies on this as their primary income. Plus, it connects us to people we might not otherwise get to know.
- 2. **Increased fellowship** There are so many ways in which we get to work together in order to make PigaPalooza happen. This working together is fellowship in action. Between cutting tin foil, preparing the pork butts, setting up the smokers, smoking the meat, and delivering the product we are connecting with one another. God is so good to us for the wonderful opportunity this particular work affords us with so much fellowship.
- 3. **Raising Funds** Yes it does provide dollars and cents for our local and global outreach efforts. One of which is Little Lambs in Guatemala that provides orphans with a home and resources to help those in need.

Take some time to join in our efforts to serve others in love. Also, be praying for opportunities that this will give us to share the gospel.
