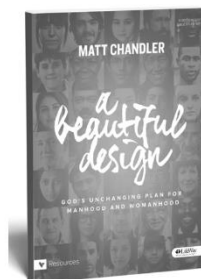

### Lenten Prayer Everyday

Wednesday, March 6, was the beginning of the Lenten season. This is a 40-day season (Mar. 6-Apr. 14) for preparing for the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior. We take time to reflect on the long road ahead of our Savior as he prepared to “suffer many things and be rejected by the elders and the chief priests and the scribes and be killed, and after three days rise again” (Mark 8:31b).
