<u>P2P (PASTOR TO PEOPLE)</u> Behold the Beauty of Christ's Resurrection



"Let there be light" is the first words of God in Genesis 1:3. Darkness preceded light. The Gospel of John uses this idea of light-darkness dualism (cf. John 3:2; 11:10; 13:30) to help us "see" with eyes of faith (John 20:31) as John concludes his gospel account. Light gives us what we need every day: the ability to see what is around us. However physical light is a beautiful picture of Christ's beauty if resurrection. An artist friend of mine (Eva Flatscher) created a beautiful piece of lightpainting called, ""no Light no Life" along with choreographer Marla Hirokawa. This collaborative portrait will cast a male dancer as the Van Gogh character and a female dancer as the personification of Art. A third character, the LIGHTPAINTING produced by Flatscher during performance will portray color as perceived by Van Gogh. Essential to the theme and collaborative spirit of this work are the points of improvisation woven into the piece that give the dancers, Eva, and the musicians' personal, creative expression.

Next Sunday you will be given the opportunity to share the light of Christ's beauty by bringing in a piece of art (song, music, poem, painting, drawing, etc.) that you offer to God in worship. God creates, we fall, God restores and my prayer this resurrection Sunday you will "see" Christ's beauty in new ways in the light of his glory. May we all praise the One who is risen and conquered sin and death through the marvelous work of the Cross and the Resurrection.


