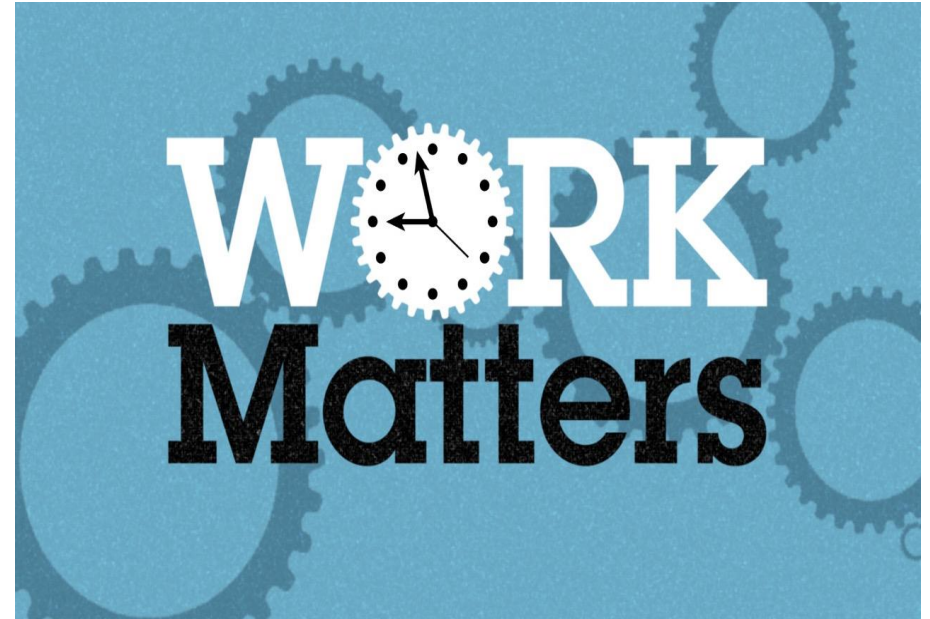

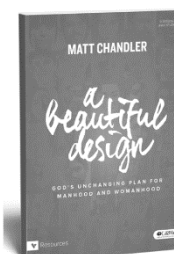

Work Matter to God

Today we begin a new series based on Colossians 3:23-24. These verses and this month will focus on the book of Colossians at a high altitude. Our primary focus will be on how in God's economy (how He intends to run things in His kingdom) He puts a high value on work. The Latin word for work is vocare which translated into English is calling. We use vocare in our English word, vocation, to share what our calling is in life. This doesn't mean only the work I do for a living (often my job) but ALL the work God gives me to do (e.g., dishes, mowing the lawn, planning a wedding, etc.). Your work matters to God and my hope this month is that you will begin to see more clearly how God's work through you (being in Christ) will transform your everyday work.
