

The project was some sort of pottery that I probably messed up. Nonetheless, I was so proud and thankful to be able to offer up something for my mother in honor of here service to me. It was a token of my grateful heart for ALL that my mother did for me. As I reflect back on those days as a child and a son of a wonderful mother, I can't but help think about Colossians 3:18-23. Paul gives instructions on how husbands, wives, parents, children, and slaves were to relate to one another. I find it very interesting that outside of wives and parents there is nothing overtly said about mothers. Ephesians 6:2 and Exodus 20:12 does say to honor your father and mother but Colossians doesn't. The silence in Colossians is closely connected to this idea that "whatever you do" should be as "working to the Lord, not men." So as you honor and appreciate your mother's today do it not to them only but first as "unto the Lord Christ". If your mother is no longer with you encourage another mother or a woman desiring to be a mother one day. By so doing you will be serving the "Lord Christ" and this will bring joy to our Father who is in heaven.
