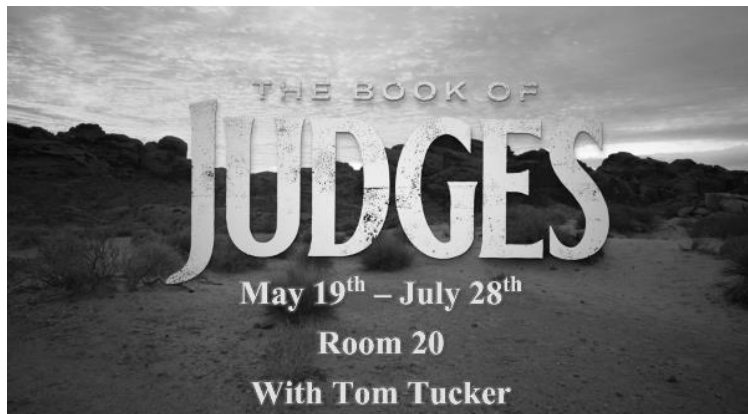

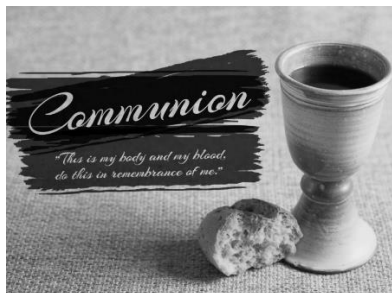
P2P (PASTOR TO PEOPLE)



The Nile Valley is 930 miles long and varies in width from 2 to 10 miles. Stretching the length of Egypt from north to south and occupying a depression around the Nile River, it occupies 3 percent of Egypt's land but is home to 96 percent of its people. It is little wonder so many of the ancient Egyptian gods were somehow connected with this river. The Nile river flows north and thus the northern part of the country is called Lower Egypt, while the southern part is called Upper Egypt. This river is so vital to the nation, its flow even influences what is called upper and lower Egypt, contrary to logic. When God was ready to free His people from slavery, the Nile River thus was the perfect initial target.

Exodus 7:20-21 says Moses struck the water and the Nile turned to blood and all the fish died and the river stunk. I can't begin to imagine the reaction of the Egyptians since their lives so depended on the Nile, and yet stubbornly they still refused to obey God. Sadly, we often are just as stubborn, continuing to live in ways that we know are in disobedience. May God help us be compliant to His will.

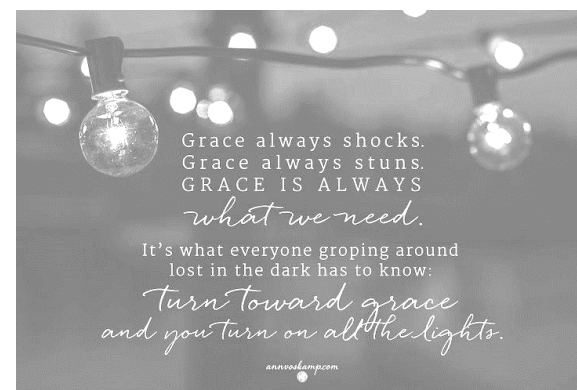
