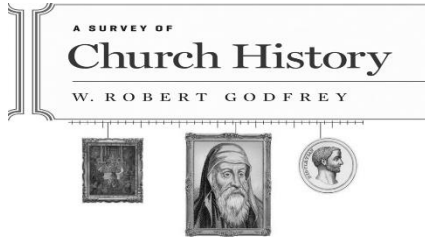
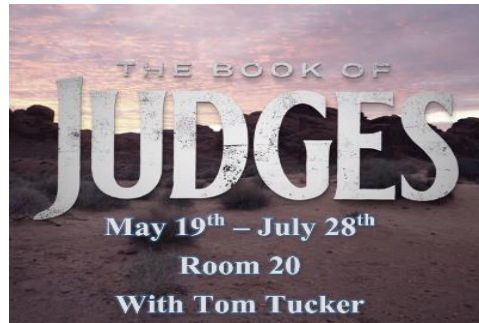

P2P (PASTOR TO PEOPLE) **Our Father's On Father's Day**



"My dad is better than your dad", was an often-heard phrase in my elementary school. I truly believed that if my friend's father was up against my father, my father would win. Most of us truly believe our fathers were the best, at least as compared to other earthly fathers. However the truth is that most if not all father's fall short of being the kind of men God calls us to be. Nonetheless the Bible uses the idea of Fatherhood to describe the God of the universe. He is our Father who is in heaven. He provides for his children and cares for them providing the bread we need to live. Dr. Steven Lawson says, "No one symbol of the Bible can communicate the whole. So, it requires many different metaphors, many different analogies, to even begin to try to [understand] the totality of the invincible power of the inerrant Word." The Bible is full of images, symbols, and metaphors that God uses to help us know Him and relate to Him. This actually helps us to know ourselves. The metaphor and reality that God is our Father brings hope to us Father's and children. Hope that even though we will often mourn the inability of our earthly father, our Father can and will give us all that we need through His son, Jesus Christ. This Father's Day give thanks for both your earthly father and for the Father who gave us his Son to die for our sins so that we could be reconciled to Him forever. Happy Father's Day!
