



This is similarly stated in Acts 1:8 which is even more specific by saying, "you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth". San Pedro Pinula, Guatemala would be considered "the end of the earth". So, to that end we are sending off a team from GracePoint (Brian Grady, Robert Watson, Elizabeth Watson, Elijah Watson, John Simmons, Mason Simmons, Scott Bergman, Sherry Scheitler, Marie Paige, and Michael Reynolds) and three other churches (South Tampa Fellowship, First Baptist of Lake Placid, and First Baptist of Plant City) to be the hands, heart, and feet of Jesus Christ. There will be a total of 36 followers of Jesus Christ serving those in need. Little Lambs International will be their host home and partner in ministry while in Guatemala. Please be praying for the following planned projects that the team will be embarking on along with the relationships they build with the local families and orphans.

Projects:

- Building the first family house for the Orphanage at Little Lambs International
- Building some bunk beds
- 2-day medical mission
- Installing cook stoves
- Sports Camp
- One day of VBS

Pray for their travels to and from their mission site in San Pedro Pinula, Guatemala and that as the team works together they would collectively learn more fully what it means to "follow Jesus Christ everywhere" in this particular mission.
