



HAS GOD ABANDONED ME? PSALM 77 – A PSALM OF ASAPH

To Asaph – 1 Chronicles 16:4-5


- 1- Asaph's Complaint v1-6

P2P (PASTOR TO PEOPLE) HAS GOD FORGOTTEN?

July 20, 1969 was a significant day in the lives of all Americans. On that day Neil Armstrong took man's first steps on the moon. What many people do not know, is what took place just prior to these famous steps. Neil's cohort Buzz Aldrin was an Elder in his Presbyterian church in Houston. Prior to the first moon walk, Aldrin celebrated communion and read from the scriptures!



That's right – the first meal eaten on the lunar surface was the Lord's Supper! You probably won't learn that from most media outlets.



July 20, 1969 was also a significant day in my life as well. On the same day that our astronauts walked on the moon, I received notice that my best friend, Joe Portland, had drowned in a boating accident in New York. Joe was the first person close to me who died, and it set in motion a series of events which led me to faith and ultimately to 36 years of ministry with you!

Along the way I have often asked this question: "God, do you hear me at all? Are you even really there?" If you have walked with God for any length of time, there are probably similar times in your life when you wonder whether or not you have been abandoned by your heavenly Father.

Psalms 77:9 asks, "Has God forgotten to be merciful? Has he in anger withheld his compassion?" Our Psalm of the day is written by Asaph, an older man who had walked with God for decades. Thanks for joining us today and seeking out Asaph's answers to these critical questions.
