

# The Lord's Prayer: Theology Through the Eyes of Jesus – A 6-Week Bible Study

## Overview

This six-part series explores the Lord's Prayer as Jesus intended it: not as a ritual to recite, but as a framework for relationship, formation, and spiritual transformation. Each line of the prayer reveals a different dimension of life with God — moving us from identity to worship, from surrender to dependence, from forgiveness to spiritual victory.

At its core, the Lord's Prayer is Jesus teaching us how to live as sons and daughters in the Father's kingdom.

## Lesson Format

Each week's lesson will be structured as follows:

1. Introduction / Review – 5 mins
2. Lesson Presentation – 20 to 30 mins
3. Questions and Answers – 10 mins
