

The Upper Room Blueprint – Lesson 2 Addendum

“Allow God to Be Seen through You!”

Believers allow God to be seen through them when their lives, words, **attitudes**, and actions reflect His character. Scripture consistently teaches that God reveals Himself to the world through His people—not just through what they say, but through how they **think and live**. Here are some ways we make God visible, along with biblical references.

1. By Reflecting God’s Character

When believers show love, patience, mercy, justice, and compassion, they display who God is.

- “Be holy, for I am holy.” — 1 Peter 1:16
- “Let your light shine... that they may see your good works and glorify your Father.” — Matthew 5:16

2. By Loving Others Sacrificially

Love is the clearest evidence of God’s presence in a believer’s life.

- “By this all people will know that you are my disciples, if you have love for one another.” — John 13:35
- “God is love... whoever abides in love abides in God.” — 1 John 4:16

3. By Living with Integrity and Obedience

Obedience reveals trust, and trust reveals God’s authority and goodness.

- “If you love Me, you will keep My commandments.” — John 14:15
- “Walk in a manner worthy of the Lord.” — Colossians 1:10

4. By Demonstrating the Fruit of the Spirit

The Spirit’s work in a believer’s life is visible evidence of God’s transforming power.

- Galatians 5:22–23 — love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control

5. By Speaking Words of Grace and Truth

Believers reveal God when their speech builds up rather than tears down.

- “Let your speech always be gracious.” — Colossians 4:6
- “Speak the truth in love.” — Ephesians 4:15

6. By Sharing the Gospel Boldly

Proclaiming Christ is one of the clearest ways believers reveal God’s heart.

- “Ye are our epistle written in our hearts...read of all men — 2 Corinthians 3:2
- “Always be prepared to give an answer for the hope that is in you.” — 1 Peter 3:15
