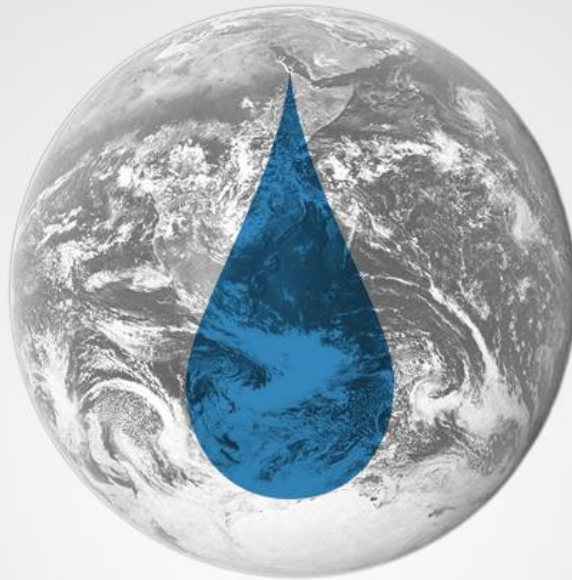

 - A disciple is an apprentice or student of a teacher.

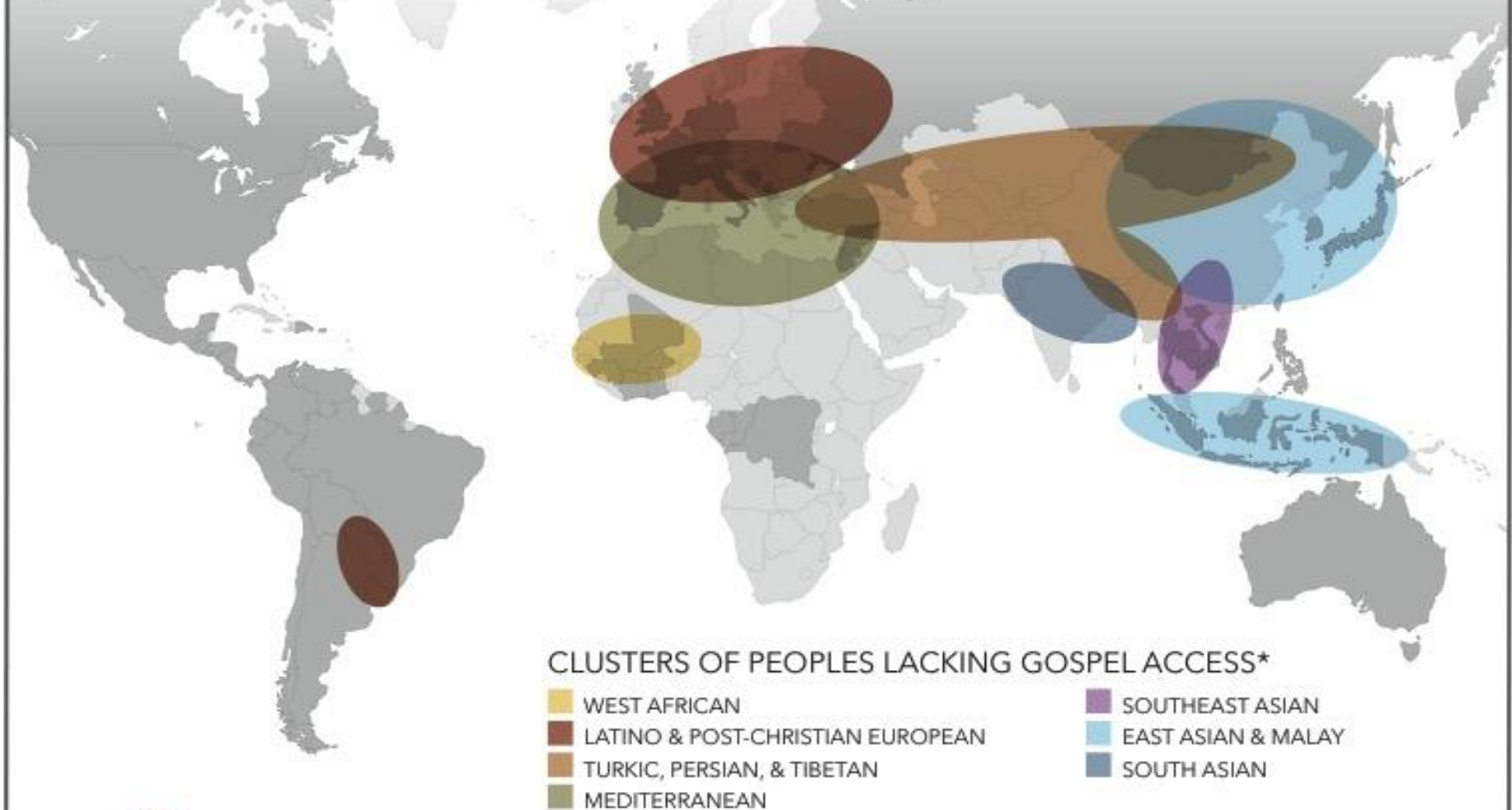


The Call

Who are we supposed to make disciples of?

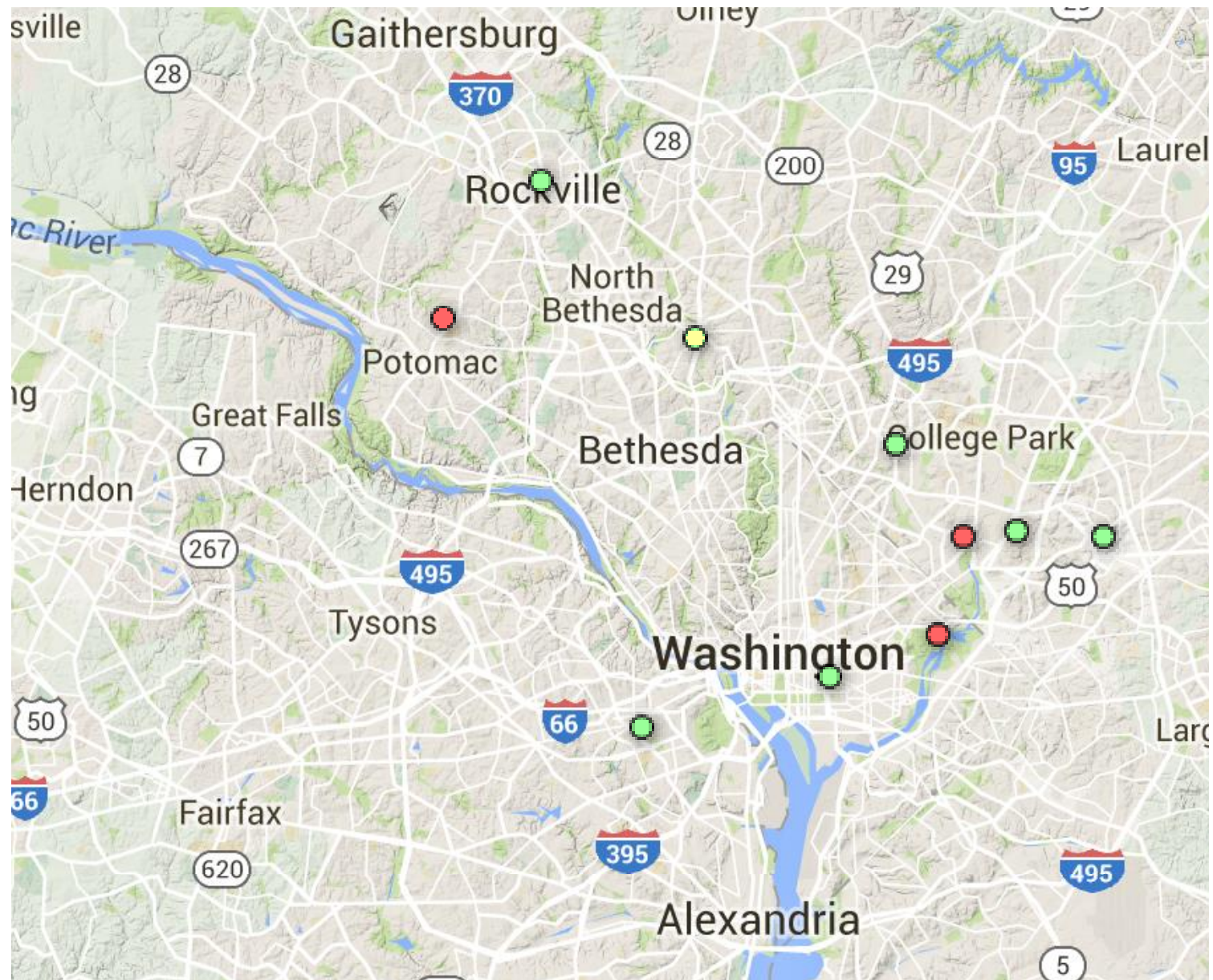
—all nations — all people groups

PRAY *for* PEOPLES *of the* WORLD



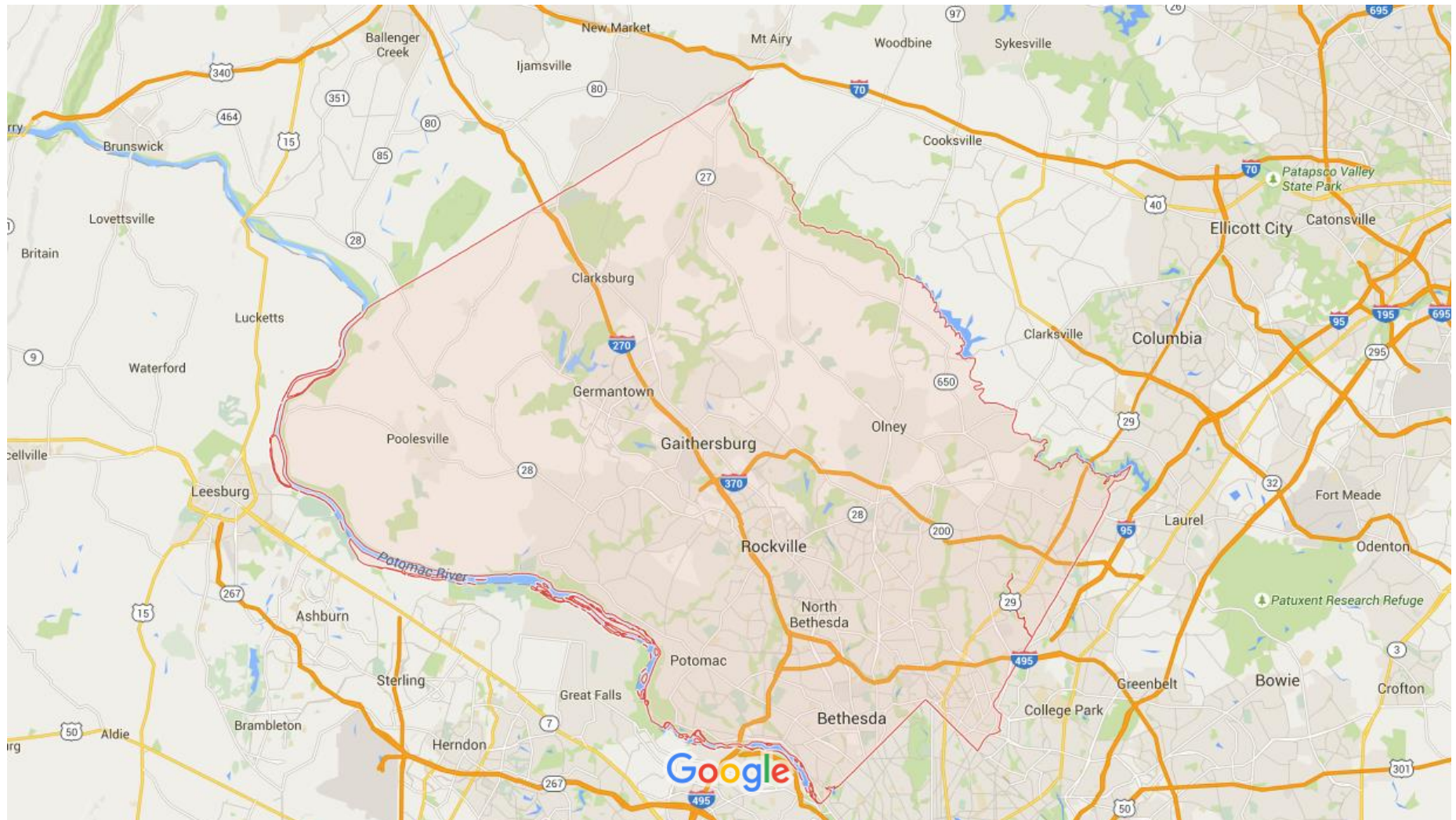
16,000 people groups = 7billion+ people
