Students must meet the following criteria to be considered for the award:

- 1. The scholarship applicant must be an active member of Olivet Baptist Church.
- 2. Must participate in church activities.
- 3. Must be a high school senior graduating in the fall, spring or summer of your senior year.
- 4. Submit a sealed official copy of your transcript. Do not open envelope.
- 5. Have a grade point average of 2.00 ("C" average) or higher.
- 6. Submit a typed written essay of 250-300 words.
- 7. Plan to attend an Institution of Higher Learning
- 8. Submit two letters of recommendation
- 9. Submit a resume'

If you become a recipient of the Gladys Batiste Scholarship, you must:

- a. Submit a written statement, with proof of enrollment to the college of your choice.
- b. You must be enrolled in six (6) hours or more of classes by January 31, 2021 and continue to maintain a semester grade point average of 2.0 or higher. Otherwise, the recipient will forfeit the scholarship the following school term. In order to be reinstated, the recipient must earn a 2.0 or higher and be enrolled in 6 hours or more of classes the following school term. The recipient becomes eligible to receive a scholarship for the next school term, providing he or she submits a copy of their class schedule for the new school term and an official transcript for the previous school term class grades.

<u>DEADLINE</u>: The required application, essay, resume and two letters of reference must be postmarked no later than <u>January 26, 2021</u> to be considered for the scholarship award (no exceptions). <u>Your official transcript is due not later than 10 days after your graduation date</u>.
