Words of Encouragement....

Mark 6:31-32 Then Jesus said, "Let's go off by ourselves to a quiet place and rest awhile..." So they left... for a quiet place, where they could be alone. NLT

You have probably heard by now what the "big announcement" was on Sunday, Feb. 5th. We are planning a church-wide retreat for next year. The dates for our retreat will be **Feb. 2–4, 2018**.

In the verse above, Jesus encouraged His disciples to go with Him to an out-of-the-way place so they could be together away from the hustle and bustle of everyday activities. There is something refreshing and re-energizing about "getting away" to spend some concentrated time hearing from the Lord and fellowshipping with fellow believers. A retreat away to a quiet place affords such an opportunity.

The Lord began laying this idea on my heart this past summer when our kids and youth came back from their respective camps and shared during our worship service what the Lord had done in their hearts while they were at camp. The blessing they experienced and excitement they felt spilled-over onto us. And I began to think and pray about how the whole church fellowship could experience God in a similar way and be re-energized in our soul.

I shared this idea with the ministerial staff and the Deacon leadership, and both groups seemed to bear witness with the idea and encouraged me to continue pursuing what the Lord had laid on my heart.

Our theme for the weekend will be "How Great Is Our God!" And Mike Satterfield will be our guest speaker. Mike is a prominent speaker among Texas Baptists. He is on staff as a Teaching Pastor at Fielder Church in Arlington and regularly speaks at camps, retreats and conferences. Mike is a spirit-filled, energetic preacher and teacher – and I know the Lord will bring a timely message to us through him.

While the adults and youth are having our sessions and small group times, our kids $(1^{st} - 5^{th})$ grades) will be having their own simultaneous sessions with their own leaders from Howard Payne University. And nursery care will be provided during those same times for newborns through kindergarten.

Our retreat will be held at Riverbend Retreat Center in Glen Rose, TX; with a cost of \$15 per person or \$45 per family of 3 or more. Activities will begin with dinner at 7:00 pm on Friday, Feb 2nd, and end following lunch on Sunday, Feb 4th. For those who might need transportation, we will be taking our vans. Sign-up sheets for the retreat and for transportation will be provided this coming fall/winter.

What you need to do now is plan ahead and adjust your schedule to take timeoff so you can attend our retreat on Feb. 2–4, 2018. Mark your calendars and begin to pray for this exciting and important weekend together. Please pray for those who will be attending, our speaker and children's leaders, a re-energizing of our church fellowship, good weather for the weekend, and for all the financial needs for the retreat to be met.

There has been a special activity account set up for those whom the Lord would lead to give toward covering the total cost for this event. Please pray about whether the Lord would have you give toward this important weekend for our church.



Ecclesiastes is outstanding wisdom literature and it offers us the chance to learn from somebody who did things the wrong way. What a wonderful book to study with our youth group. So often we want to tell them of the potential dangers that lie ahead if they don't live according to God's Word. This is what the



book of Ecclesiastes does. It's wisdom from a life lived apart from God. We chase so many things in life: money, popularity, power, and we often put God on the backburner as we pursue the things that we think will make us happy. Happiness isn't the thing to pursue because happiness is based on your happenings and it can have wild swings from one end of the pendulum to the other. Instead we should seek the eternal joy that is only found in knowing Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. The writer of Ecclesiastes ends the book with this, "That's the whole story. Here now is my final conclusion: Fear God and obey his commands, for this is everyone's duty. God will judge us for everything we do, including every secret thing, whether good or bad." Now that is a message that all of us, regardless of age, need to hear.
