Our church-wide retreat for next year, Feb 2-4, 2018, will be here before we know it.

I hope you are already making plans to attend and participate in this wonderful weekend away with our church fellowship.

This retreat will be a major focus for the church next year. Our theme for the weekend will be "How Great Is Our God!" And Mike Satterfield will be our guest speaker. Mike is on staff as a Teaching Pastor at Fielder Church in Arlington and regularly speaks at camps, retreats and conferences. He is a spirit-filled, energetic preacher and teacher – and I know the Lord will bring a timely message to us through him.

As the verse above indicates, Jesus encouraged His disciples to go with Him to an out-of-the-way place so they could be together away from the hustle and bustle of everyday activities. There is something refreshing and re-energizing about "getting away" to spend some concentrated time hearing from the Lord and fellowshipping with fellow believers. This retreat away to a quiet place affords such an opportunity for us as a church fellowship.

Riverbend Retreat Center in Glen Rose, TX, will host our retreat. The cost we are charging for the weekend is only \$15 per person or \$45 per family of 3 or more. This includes 2 nights' stay, 6 meals, and honorariums for our guest speaker, worship leaders, and children's leaders.

Obviously, the cost we are charging will not cover all the expenses. Because we don't want the cost for the weekend to be a deterrent to anyone wanting to participate, we have intentionally kept the price low. The total estimated cost for the retreat with 135 people attending is \$15,000. The church plans to cover the difference in expenses and the money received, by budgeting for the retreat in the 2018 budget.

If you would like to help with the total costs for the retreat, a special activity account has been set-up to receive financial donations. Every dollar the church receives toward the costs of the retreat will be one less dollar needed in next year's budget.

Would you please prayerfully consider contributing toward our Church-wide retreat?

How wonderful and God-honoring it would be for all \$15,000 to be donated this year before we begin the 2018 budgeting process this fall. We all experientially know that God has repeatedly proven Himself to FBC Bangs by faithfully meeting our financial needs. And as a church fellowship, you have been so faithful to give to the ministries of our church and the work of God. I have every confidence that the Lord will meet this need as well.

So please pray that this financial need would be met – and whether the Lord would have you give toward this need. If you would like to give, please write "Church Retreat" on the memo line of your check.

Thank you for praying for this retreat, for planning to attend, and for considering giving to cover the costs of this important weekend for our church.
