Malachi 3:10 > "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough... If you do," says the LORD..., "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!" [NLT]

1 Corinthians 16:2 > On the first day of every week, each one of you should set aside a sum of money in keeping with your income.... [NIV]

2 Corinthians 9: 6-7 \succ "But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. So let each one give as he purposes in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion; for God loves a cheerful giver." [NIV]

God calls us to be good stewards of what He has entrusted to us. "Stewardship" means managing something that belongs to someone else. A steward is not a possessor or owner, but recognizes that it doesn't belong to her/him. God is our source and as His people we are all stewards of what really belongs to Him. Thus, God expects each of us to manage well the resources He has given us.

The guestion is: Are you a good steward or not? It's not a guestion of what or how much God has given us. He wants us to be faithful and act responsibly with everything -- whether it's spiritual gifts and talents, or financial resources, or personal time. Stewardship is much more than a money issue! It's an issue of the heart ("where your heart is, there is your treasure"). The stewardship we practice and live is a barometer of our spiritual condition. It's kind of like our spiritual heart monitor. If we get our heart right – our head, hands, and finances will follow.

The spiritual reality is this: stewardship and giving are inextricably and eternally connected. How we manage our money and resources as stewards is directly linked to our spiritual well-being. It's not *what you have* that's at issue, but *what has you!* The heart will follow what's important to it (its treasure).

Of the 38 parables Jesus told, 16 of them are about money. The Bible has fewer than 300 verses on the subject of prayer; less than 500 verses on the subject of faith. But there are over 2,000 verses that deal with wealth, possessions and money. The inescapable conclusion is this: how we deal with our finances in general, and what we give in particular, is a BIG DEAL to God.

Certainly, this has bearing on our personal finances. But it also has significant impact on our Church finances. We must be faithful to give of ourselves and our resources to help carry out God's call on our lives through the ministries and efforts of First Baptist Church.

I want to be sure to avoid any sense of legalism here. A tithe is one-tenth. This is the only area of discipleship that has a specific number attached to it. We're not told to pray "x" number of times a day or week. We're not instructed how often to read our Bible or to worship. But we do have this number-*one-tenth*-to guide us in our giving. While the tithe does figure into New Testament thinking at various times, it's not as significantly emphasized as it is in the Old Testament. But I Corinthians 16:2 says guite a lot about being *punctual* in our giving ("On the first day of each week"), *personal* in our giving ("each one of you"), and *proportional* in our giving ("in keeping with your income").

More "Words of Encouragement. . . . "

If you say that you love and obey God, then here's a pretty good test – how's your giving? Giving through tithes and offerings is a litmus test of the nature of your relationship with God and your faithfulness to Him. We see this demonstrated in the different responses of Zacheus in Luke 19: 8-9 and the rich young ruler in Mark 10: 21-22.

SERVE and GO!

While we're no longer under the Law of the Old Covenant that requires a tithe (10%), we are under the New Covenant of Grace that expects us to give because of the grace and love we've been given. We are not compelled by law, but by grace. The New Testament presents a new model of giving we are urged to practice. God still expects us to give back to Him, but our motivation for *giving is different* – love, grace, and obedience. Interestingly, the one thing Jesus actually confirmed that the Scribes and Pharisees were doing well was tithing (Matthew 23:23). Adrian Rogers used to say, "Any Christian who allows a Jew under the law to give more than a Christian under grace, is a disgrace to grace."

Tithing, then, is a good benchmark for believers – a good place to start. It's a good reminder of who is in charge of my life. God wants what my money represents - me. When giving to God, we're just taking our hands off what belongs to Him in the first place. It's a demonstration of our trust in God and an expression of our gratitude to Him. It's also God's plan for providing the things needed for His house, His servants, and the needs of His kingdom work.

Over and over again, our Lord comes back to motive. When we give, when we pray, when we worship, or whatever we do, God looks at our heart. Motive is everything. When we recognize that everything we have comes from God and that He provides it for us with a purpose in mind, then every believer should be motivated to give a portion of his finances to the Lord on a regular basis. We each must make that decision; invest in spiritual things, and store up treasures in heaven.

God has been so very good and faithful to us! And, He continues to do a good work among us. Be faithful to do what you know to do. Listen to the voice of His Spirit in you and follow His leading. Love each other. Encourage each other in your walk of service and stewardship; and give cheerfully. It will glorify and bless Him; and you, too, will be blessed. Pepper
