"... just as sin reigned in death, so also grace might reign through righteousness to bring eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord." Romans 5:21

Theme of Romans: The gospel of Jesus Christ reveals the righteousness of God by faith for the Jew and the Gentile as foretold by the Law and the Prophets.

Big idea today: You can build Christ's church with confidence because . . .

Romans 1:16-17 For I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God that brings salvation to everyone who believes . . . righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."

1:18-3:20 All have sinned and deserve death.

3:21-5:11 God makes righteousness available through the sacrifice of Christ.

Justify, redeem, atone, save, reconcile, adopt. Example of Abraham "by Faith"

Message Outline:
