Message Outline:

Here’s how it happened...

v.1 “Did God really say?”

v. 2 “but God did say...”

A great answer, with 3 notable revisions:

- Minimized by giving location, not name
- Modified by adding “not even touch”
- Misrepresented by omitting “certainly”

***Satan not named in Genesis, but identified clearly in Revelation 12:9 and 20:2*

v. 4-5 Contradiction “You will certainly not die”

Adds motive: *“For God knows...”*

v. 6 Sin looks desirable,

... & appears to have no consequences

v. 7 The immediate results of sin

v. 8-13 Sin looks desirable, no consequences?

v. 14f The consequences

v. 15 The hope—a plan!

Romans 5:12-19 Explains the plan

... by comparing Adam to Christ.

God’s motives have never changed or waived:

2 Peter 3:9 *“...not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance.”*
