General Assembly 2017 is over but it was definitely one for the history books! The Christian Church (Disciples of Christ) elected our new General Minister and President, Rev. Theresa Hord Owens, who is the first African-American woman to head, not only our denomination, but the first African-American woman to lead any mainline protestant denomination. This is not the first time that the Disciples of Christ have made history; however. Our outgoing General Minister and President, Rev. Dr. Sharon E. Watkins, became the first female to lead a mainline denomination when she was elected in 2005



In addition to the election of our new General Minister and President, numerous resolutions were approved that re-affirmed our commitment as a denomination to honor and respect all persons and celebrate the diversity of gifts that we each bring to the table. With its basis found in Jesus' prayer in John 17:20-21, the theme that we would all be "ONE" resonated throughout the Assembly during the business sessions, various workshops and nightly worship services.




