Experience the Changing International Learning Center

After teaching English as a Second Language (ESL) for the last 44 years in a classroom setting, ILC is praying about opening as a hybrid center. That is, some in person classes and some virtual classes.

Let me give you a little background information. ILC began teaching ESL in Gainesville, Florida in 1976 under Waldo and Verda Wood where Mrs. Wood wrote much of the curriculum because very little ESL Christian materials were available. Throughout the past 44 years, volunteers have provided English classes to the internationals in North Central Florida. Most of our students were only in the area for a year or two and then returned to their country. Therefore, ILC felt like it not only taught English but also knew that we were **international missionaries as we spent time demonstrating the love of Jesus. We prayed that our students would take the love of Jesus home with them.**

In 2020, ILC received for the 13th consecutive year the Business Hall of Fame Gainesville Award in the Religious area.

We now come to a time where we have one teacher who is willing to teach in a classroom, another teacher who will teach only outside under a tree and still another who will teach only in a virtual classroom.

It is time to lean toward what is changing instead of grieving the past. We are embracing the future of change. ILC is praying for teachers. We need at least 2 to teach in a classroom of 6-8 students on Monday and Wednesday 9-11am. We also need at least 2 teachers to teach a 60-90 minute class via the computer once or twice a week.

Currently a teacher is teaching a virtual class on Wednesday evening to 10 students. Some of the students are in Gainesville, while 3 former students are in Brazil and a former student who is in Philadelphia has asked to join the class. The opportunities seem to be unlimited. Therefore, **ILC is embracing the change that has been forced upon us.**
