Did you know?

Church of the Resurrection, by the numbers:

Amount we expect it will take to operate Church of the Resurrection in 2022: **\$528,885**

Barrels of food gathered for Monument Crisis Center last year: **36**

Working Towards Sustainability

Over the past several years, our operating budget has had a deficit. Thankfully, we have had the financial reserves necessary to cover these budget gaps, but we can't depend on that moving forward. This year, as we strive to move towards a sustainable and balanced budget, we are aiming to reduce our deficit by half. To do so, pledges across the church need to increase by \$23,000. Our journey towards sustainability begins today.
