As you may already know, the CDC has changed their guidelines again, recommending gatherings of less than 10 people for 8 weeks. As you may have discovered, this includes Holy Week. Our Worship staff met yesterday to process this new reality.

Please be encouraged by Pastor Tom's message below:

"We join all of you in the emotion of grief and the experience of loss. To imagine NOT gathering together as a church family for the next several weeks leaves a hole in our hearts. More than anything els, e on a day-to-day basis, we get ready for and lead worship. The bigger sense of loss comes from imagining a Holy Week without the rhythms we are used to. Short of a miracle, Holy Week 2020 will be unlike any other in the past or future. By then, we will have found some avenues of being the Church that are new and life-giving, tried and failed at a thing or two, and gained new evidence of God's faithfulness and power. Then there are our heartbeats of discipleship and mission that will be greatly challenged - Children's and Youth Ministry, small groups, ShareFest and more. What we will do is unknown for now; THAT God will show us what, how and when to do something new is undeniable. This is why we have to listen more closely than ever; be still and expectant. This is why we must discern and do God's will together. Maybe the last few years of learning to slow down and listen together was preparing us "for such a time as this!"
