Questions for Personal Reflection or Small Group Discussion

1. Of the attitudes for giving Paul highlights (Willing, Cheerful, Confident and Grateful), which do you resonate with most? Which is the least natural for you?
2. What are the realities in your life that make these attitudes/mindsets more difficult to embody?
3. In the midst of this pandemic, and all of the uncertainty it brings – including financial uncertainty – how confident are you that God will provide? What evidence do you have of His provision from your past?
4. When God provides for you financially, is your first thought typically what can I do, buy, GET for myself, or what can I do, buy, GIVE to others?
5. In what specific ways do you hear God calling you to give?
6. What does this passage have to say about being "Rooted in Jesus, Growing in His Love [Together], [and] Branching Out to Serve Others"?
