21 DAYS OF PRAYER TO START THE YEAR, Jan. 4 –27, 2021
Days 1 - 5

DAY 1

SCRIPTURE READING

The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. I say to myself, "The Lord is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in him!" —Lam. 3:22-24 (NLT)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Say a prayer of gratitude for God's faithfulness and endless mercies.
- Pray the verses from Lamentations aloud in defiant declaration against any forces of darkness that may be coming against you.

DAY 2

SCRIPTURE READING

"Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—His good, pleasing and perfect will." —Rom. 12:1-2 (NIV)

"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways," declares the Lord. As the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways and my thoughts than your thoughts. —Isa. 55:8-9 (NIV)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Ask God to illuminate to you any limiting beliefs, areas of confirmation bias or internal narratives that do not align with the Word of God.
- Pray for the Holy Spirit's transformation through the renewal of your mind.
- Ask the Lord to grant you understanding of things above, and for increased measures of faith that his word will not return void.

DAY 3

SCRIPTURE READING – Psalm 51

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- As we commence these 21 days, pray Psalm 51 personalizing it from a posture of contrition, confession and repentance.
- Ask God to give you a tender, responsive heart, and walk in the grace, joy and deliverance he has for you.
- Pray for a willing spirit, and ask the Lord for perpetual praise to be demonstrated in greater ways in your life.

DAY 4

SCRIPTURE READING

"Listen!" says Jesus. "I am coming soon! I will bring my rewards with me, to give to each one according to what he has done. -Revelation 22:12 (GNT)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Be alert at all times, pray so that you have the power to escape everything that is about to happen and to stand in front of the Son of Man – Luke 21:36 (GW)

DAY 5

SCRIPTURE READING

"But you, oh Lord are a shield around me, my glory and the one who lifts my head high." -Psalm 3:3

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Pray that in times of trouble the Holy Spirit will remind you of what Noah and his family did. They trusted God. They felt assured and at peace that the raging waters and wind outside the ark posed no threat to them. You are safe and dry in the refuge of God. Let the winds rage, the heathen rage and the enemy rise up. God's angels will protect and deliver you in the midst of it all.
