Days 6-10

DAY 6

SCRIPTURE READING

“I will grant peace in the land, and you will lie down and no one will make you afraid. I will remove wild beasts from the land, and the sword will not pass through your country.” —Lev. 26:6 (NLT)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Let us pray for the peace of God to rule the USA today and the days ahead.

DAY 7

SCRIPTURE READING

“For I know what I have planned for you,’ says the LORD. ‘I have plans to prosper you, not to harm you. I have plans to give you a future filled with hope. When you call out to me and come to me in prayer, I will hear your prayers. When you seek me in prayer and worship, you will find me available to you. If you seek me with all your heart and soul, I will make myself available to you,’ says the LORD. ‘Then I will reverse your plight and will regather you from all the nations and all the places where I have exiled you,’ says the LORD. ‘I will bring you back to the place from which I exiled you. —Jer. 29:11-14 (NET)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Do you believe these words? God is faithful to honor his words to us. If you have unbelief, ask him to help you with it. Read Mark 9:20-25 where Jesus does not rebuke the father of the boy for admitting that he had unbelief, but rather he healed the boy. Pray and be honest with God about and concerns you may have about the future and then rest and be at peace knowing that when you get there so too will he be.

DAY 8

SCRIPTURE READING

“Then, after doing all those things, I will pour out my Spirit upon all people. Your sons and daughters will prophesy. Your old men will dream dreams, and your young men will see visions. In those days I will pour out my Spirit even on servants—men and women alike. – Joel 2:28-29 (NLT)
But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.” – Acts 1:8 (NLT)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Pray for a fresh anointing, and receive the Spirit’s outpouring.
- Ask God to give you divine dreams, visions and prophetic insight.
- Pray that the church would bear fruitful witness, and for revival to be brought to our communities, states, nation and world.

DAY 9

SCRIPTURE READING

But those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint. —Isaiah 40:31 (NIV)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Ask God for patience in the waiting.
- Pray for renewed strength, elevated perspective and courage to rise above present circumstances.
- Pray for discernment of whether to run or walk in each given situation, and believe for His promise of endurance.

DAY 10

SCRIPTURE READING

“I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt so that you would no longer be slaves to the Egyptians; I broke the bars of your yoke and enables you to walk with heads held high. – Lev. 26:13 (NIV)

PRAYER/ REFLECTION

- Dear Lord, thank you for carrying my burdens. You say in Your word that You have “shattered the yokes that broke [my] back and that [You’ve] helped [me] walk upright” (Leviticus 26:13. I pray that You will help me surrender my will to Yours Lord. I know that You are far better that I can fathom.
