Registration:

In order to come to camp with us, you must complete these and turn in to the church office or Pastor Joel by January 27th:

- Payment

Important Details:

- The cost of camp is \$110 and is due Jan 27 with registration. Partial and full Scholarships are available (Please talk to Pastor Joel).
- We will leave Friday, February 8th at 1:30 from Bethlehem Chapel (You will have to miss part of the school day).
- Camp will be at Silver Lake Camp in Medical Lake, WA this year.
- We will return Sunday, February 10th at approximately 2:00pm to Bethlehem Chapel. (We will stop in Ritzville for lunch on the way home. Please bring money for lunch)
- We will be doing many fun activities both inside and out, please make sure to bring the right clothes!

What to Bring:

- Sleeping bag, blanket & pillow.
- Clothes for 3 days – Clothes will get wet in the snow, bring lots of warm clothes!
- Boots or warm shoes
- Toiletries – toothbrush, toothpaste, towel: all the stuff to keep you smelling good!
- Bible, pen/pencil, notebook – These items will be used during services.
- Flashlight
- Spending Money (lunch while traveling, etc.)
- Medication with Medication form filled out.

WHAT NOT TO BRING:
