

Worship of the True God – New Testament

Jesus Christ

Luke 1:42-45 – The reality of the holy baby in Mary's womb confirmed by the reaction of the baby in Elizabeth's womb. Elizabeth declares that Mary and her baby are blessed. Confirmation also

46-55 – Mary responds in worship (the Magnificat) - *(When we see God is doing what He that what the angel told Mary, God is performing it.

Luke 1:says, we should respond in worship)

Luke 2:13,14; 2:20 – When Jesus is born the heavenly hosts praise, and when the shepherds find the new born Savior, they leave glorifying and praising. They come into agreement with heaven, which is already glorifying and praising. Our worship must be in agreement with heaven, which already knows the truth, knows who God is, knows who is worthy of praise.

Mathew 2:10,11 – The wise men that came from the east, when they found the Christ, now a young child, they rejoiced with great joy, fell down before Him and worshipped Him, and opened treasures before Him of gold, frankincense and myrrh. We worship the Lord also with our substance, our tangible gifts. He is the Lord and He is worthy.

Mathew 21:5-9 – Jesus make his entry into the city of Jerusalem (really announcing that he is the Messiah) and the people praised. We praise Him when He enters into our lives, and into our situation. We praise Him when he comes to intervene and to fight for us. Ps. 24:9,10 – Lift up your heads, O ye gates; even lift them up, ye everlasting ddoors; and the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, he is the King of glory.

Worshipping Christ while on earth:

Mt 8:2; 9:18; 14:33 15:25 – leper, Jairus (worship before the request), disciples after a save, unworthy Caananite woman worshipped. Mark 5:6 demoniac worships before deliverance, Mark 15:19 – insincere act of worship.
