2.	We live in a <u>post</u> -Christian world.
Ť	We've got to quit lamenting the fact that we live in a post-Christian world and begin to do what we're called to do: take the gospel to the people who <u>need</u> it.
	How do we as Christians respond in light of Tuesday's election?
1.	Live your core: You are a Christian <u>FIRST</u> .
÷	Our commitment to the cause of Christ must span skin pigmentation and culture. It must span geographical borders and denominational lines. We must be Kingdom citizens first and foremost – before <u>anything</u> else.
Ŷ	Don't sacrifice your <u>witness</u> to Jesus on the altar of politics.

2.	Live your assignment: The only way we will ever impact our country is if we

÷	If we were as rabid about making <u>disciples</u> as some of our brethren are about making political statements, we wouldn't be where we are now.
3.	Live your command: <u>PRAY</u> .
4.	Live your guarantee: The Church has a <u>supernatural</u> defense against opposition.
Ť	Matt. 16.18: "Upon this rock I will build My church, and the gates of hell will not overpower it."
Ť	God is not limited. Period
Ť	The church that Jesus builds will not only survive, but will expand and <u>grow</u> beyond our wildest imaginations.
t	Jesus was born into a world where politically and spiritually it was as rotten as it could be. And the apostle Paul said that was the absolute <u>right</u> time for Jesus.
