Hurricane Florence Recovery Mission Trip (Oct 17-21,2022) In September 2018 Hurricane Florence devastated many communities in the Carolinas. Faith Works Coalition (FWC) responded in April 2019, repairing/restoring damaged homes. Unfortunately, the pandemic shut down most of the disaster relief efforts. Baptists on Mission in New Bern have requested our assistance with repairing some of the 60 plus homes that have not yet need restored from the hurricane damage. FWC is forming a Mission team to travel to New Bern from October 17-21, 2022. Volunteers may work all or part of the week. We will be carpooling to New Bern. Drivers should plan to arrive by 9am on Monday morning and return home on Friday. We will be staying at the Baptists on Mission – New Bern Rebuilds Center, in New Bern NC.
