Rise Against Hunger - On August 6th our congregation will participate in a meal packaging event in conjunction with Rise Against Hunger Inc., a group whose mission is growing a global movement to end hunger by empowering communities, nourishing lives and responding to emergencies. This event is designed to allow participation by everyone age 4 and over. We will turn the Fellowship Hall into our production area for a few hours and the end result will be 10,000 dehydrated, shelf-stable meals that will be transported by Rise Against Hunger to identified areas of food insecurity throughout the world. Sign-up and register either online, by QR code, or by using the sign-up sheet on the bulletin board near the Fellowship Hall. You must submit a waiver online or return it to the church office. Everyone can help. There are sitting and standing jobs. You can choose what you want to do as there is a need for people to help unload the truck, setup the fellowship hall, fill, seal and track the food bags, reload the bags on the truck and cleanup the fellowship hall. We will also need runners to move the bags from one station to another. We need everyone to participate.
