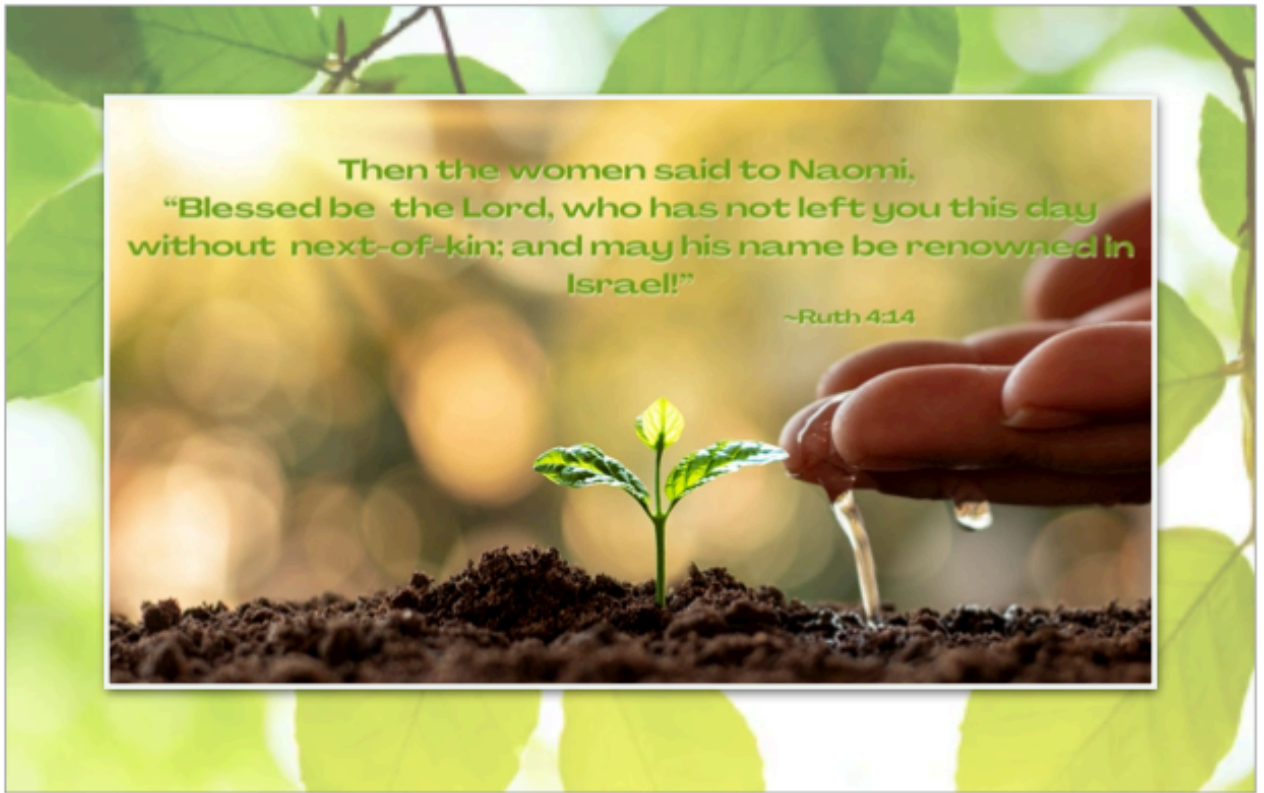

Affirmation of Faith

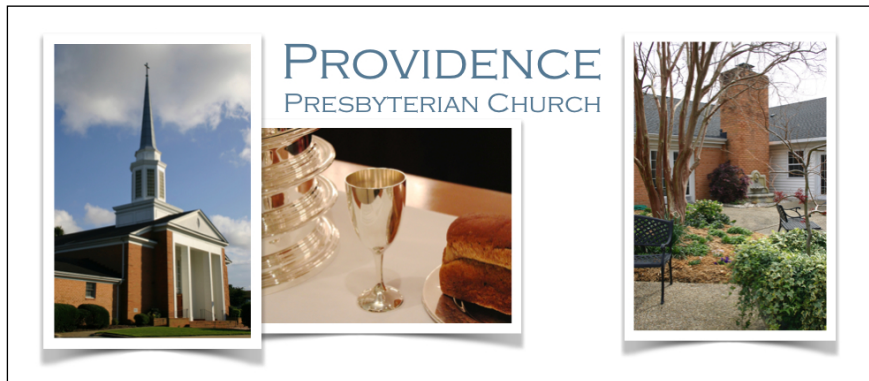
