- I. The supernatural life is a result of divine healing.
 - A. All healing comes from God. (Lu 4:40)
 - B. Man is an instrument of God.
- II. The supernatural life begins when God takes away sin.
 - A. God healed Abimelech through Abraham's prayer. (Gen 20:17)
 - B. This teaches that some sickness come from sin.
- III. The supernatural life produces a higher kind of strength.
 - A. Divine healing is getting a new kind of life and strength.
 - B. God gives supernatural strength.
- IV. The supernatural life requires faith. (Heb 11:6)
 - A. Abraham's faith
 - B. Faith allows us to trust God. (Ro 4:18-22; Eph 1:19)
 - C. The devil says, "Pity yourself..." (Mk 8:13)

- V. The supernatural life teaches that you are as good as dead. (Ro 4:19)
 - A. Do not count on your own strength for healing.
 - B. Supernatural strength comes day-by-day from God
- VI. The supernatural life teaches you to not waver.
 - A. Do not stagger or waver in life.
 - B. Abraham believed God.
 - C. Faith does not show what a man you are, but what a God you serve.
- VII. The supernatural life glorifies God.
 - A. Faith is a refresher to your life.
 - B. Strong faith brings glory to God.

 - A. Supernatural strength comes from God to our lives.
 - B. Supernatural strength is acquired by patience and faithfulness to God.
 - C. The supernatural life produces opportunity to see God's power lived through us.
