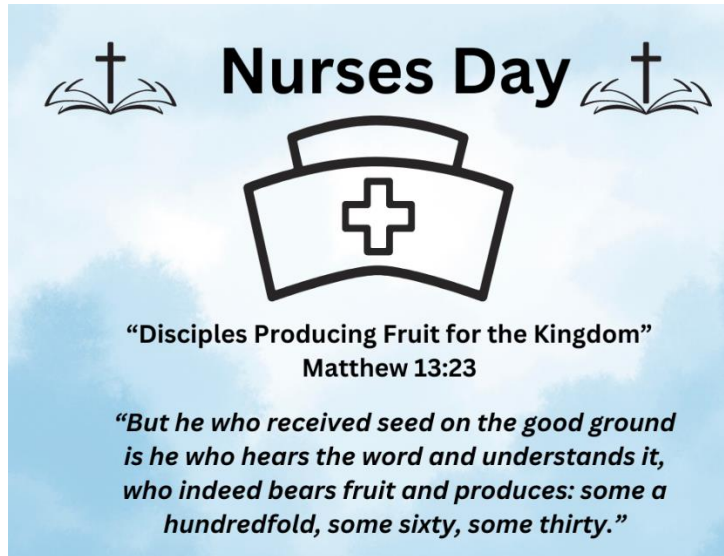

Our Guest Preacher: Rev. Dr. Joyce McPhail **Associate Minister, Berean Baptist Church**

The Reverend Doctor Joyce E. McPhail is an Associate Minister at Berean Baptist Church in Washington, DC which is pastored by the Reverend Robert G. Childs. A native of Charleston, SC, Dr. McPhail is the daughter of the late Mrs. Pearl Admiral McPhail formerly of Charleston, SC, and the late Mr. Allen Z. McPhail formerly of Hattiesburg, MS.

Dr. McPhail acknowledged her call to the ministry of the Gospel of Jesus Christ in 1997. She was licensed by Berean Baptist Church in April 1998 under the leadership of Rev. Childs and ordained by a council of Baptist ministers on May 30, 2003. She is the third female minister to be ordained in the 147 years of Berean Baptist Church.

Dr. McPhail was educated in the public-school systems in Charleston, SC and Princeton, NJ. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Urban Affairs from the College of Charleston and a Master of Public Administration degree from the College of Charleston and the University of South Carolina, Charleston, SC; and a Master of Divinity degree from the Howard University School of Divinity, Washington, DC. In May 2018, She earned a Doctor of Ministry degree from Wesley Theological Seminary, Washington, DC.

Dr. McPhail served as President of her Senior Class (2002) at Howard; President of Howard School of Divinity Alumni Association (2008-2009); and the Alumni Association's Recording Secretary (2010-2020). She also served as Teaching Assistant to Rev. Childs in the Master of Divinity Program at Howard. She was on staff at the Maple Springs Bible College and Seminary as an Associate Professor from 2019-2022. She is a charter member of the Sister Clergy Fellowship, Inc. in Washington, DC.

Dr. McPhail serves in all areas of church life at Berean Baptist Church, from preaching, teaching, and working with the children and young people. Outside of the church, Dr. McPhail has been blessed to celebrate 33 years of public service at the Department of Justice, Washington, DC. In her free time, she enjoys reading, going out to dinner, concerts, the theater, and “binge-watching on Hulu and Netflix.”

Dr. McPhail gives all honor, praise, and glory to God for the love and support of family, extended family, and friends. One of her biblical affirmations is “Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him.” (1st Corinthians 2:9, NKJV)
