# Our Preacher: Rev. Claudius Jones



Our preacher today is our very own Rev. Claudius Jones, a son of First Rising Mt. Zion Baptist Church.

Rev. Claudius Jones accepted Christ at an early age. He is a native of North Carolina, but has called the DMV area his second home –

having resided in the area for over 50 years. After serving in the US Army, he found his way to this church - First Rising Mt. Zion Baptist Church and became an active member.

He accepted his call to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and was licensed and ordained. A graduate of the Washington Baptist Seminary, he received his certification in Biblical Studies. He has served in a number of capacities within the church—including Assistant Pastor for the late Reverend Ernest R. Gibson.
