

I. Interior of the New Jerusalem(22:1 - 5)

Then the angel

showed (deiknyo = proof) me the [pure = katharos] river

1) of the water (hydor) of <u>life</u>, (zoe = source)



3) flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb

Verse 2

down the middle of the great street "street" = plateia = a broad way of the city.

On each side of the river stood the tree of life,

bearing twelve crops of fruit, (Korpos = 12 types)

vielding its fruit every month. (?)

And the leaves of the tree

are [were] for the healing (therapeian = health giving) of the nations. (ethnos = people)





Verse 3

No longer

will there be any curse. (katathema = only use here) Since the fall, man and creation have lived with the effect of the curse described in Gen. 3:16-19. Now the curse is gone!

[but] The throne of God

and of the Lamb

will be in the city,

and his servants (doulos = slave)

will serve him. (latreuo = to perform worship and other sacred services)

The curse caused all work for humanity to be difficult and arduous. Now the work of the saints in blessed and full or joy.

Verse 4

They will see his face,

"see" here is the word optanomai which is the middle active form of the word to be seen = to allow oneself to be seen!

Now we understand the words of Jesus in Matt. 5:8 - Blessed are the pure in heart: for they shall "see" God.

Paul said, "now we see dimly, but then face to face" (1 Cor. 13:12) and his name

will be on their foreheads. (metopon)

This idea of names on foreheads is used eight times in Revelation:

- 1) God seals the 144,000 evangelists. (Rev. 7:3, 9:4, 14:1)
- 2) The Beast seals his followers on the forehead. (Rev. 13:16)
- 3) Ultimately God puts his name upon the forehead of the saints.

Verse 5

There will be no more night. (nyx = death and evil) They will not need the light

of a lamp

or the light of the sun.

for the Lord God

will give them light. (photizo = reflected light)

And they will reign (basileou = serve as kings)

for ever and ever.

We have returned to Eden:

No more curse – like prior to the sin of rebellion – no fear Perfect unity with God – like prior to the sin – walked together Perfect purpose – like prior to the sin – worked together Perfect relationship – like prior to the sin – looked into each others eves.

Importance of this Book (22:6) Verse 6 The angel said to me, "These words (logos = the word of God/Picture) are trustworthy The name of Christ on the White Horse – Rev. 19:11 and true. The Lord. the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent (apostollos = apostles – one who is sent) his angel to show (deikyno = prove) his servants (doulos) the things that must soon (en = quick not soon in time) take place." The word of God was given to John to prove the things that will happen quickly. III. Jesus is Coming Soon! (22:7 - 17) Verse 7 "Behold. I am coming soon! (tachy = quickly - urgency now) Blessed is he [#6 of the Beatitudes in Revelation] who keeps (tereo = guard/obey) the words of the prophecy in this book." Ultimately we are not only to know the word but to keep it and obey it and honor it. Verse 8 I, John, am the one who heard and saw these things. And when I had heard and seen them. I fell down (pipto) to worship (proskyneo) at the feet of the angel who had been showing them to me. As John did back in Rev. 19:10.

 The simple point - if what you have read in this book as the
revelation of Jesus Christ to the world has not changed your point
of view - there is very little hope for you!
 It is one thing NOT to know (ignorance) it is quite another thing
TO KNOW and still not change (we call rebellion).

 This is likely a song or poetry with a simple point. Jesus is
coming quickly so there will be no time for change later if you are

not willing to change NOW.

In the Garden of Eden, the tree of life was protected by a guardian cherubim (Gen. 3:24) – now it is accessible forever.

 of the prophecy [from the voice of a prophet]
 of this book: (biblion = small book or scroll)

The last person speaking in the first person is Jesus.

If anyone adds (epitithemi = to impose or lay upon)
 anything to them,

God will add to him
 the plagues
 described in this book.

I warn (martyreo = to testify/witness) everyone (pas)


Some may apply this warning to the entire scriptures, but the use of "this" is singular and "book" is a single small scroll leads me to this book of Revelation only.

Verse 19

And if anyone

takes words (logos) away (aphaireo = remove)
from this book (biblion)
of prophecy,

God will take away (aphaireo = remove)
from him his share
in the tree of life
and in the holy city,
which are described
in this book.



Verse 20

He who testifies (martyreo) to these things says,

"Yes, (nia = surely, truly, verily)
I am coming soon. (tachy = quickly) "

Speaking in the first person – leads me to think Jesus is speaking here.

Amen.
Come,
Lord Jesus.

John uses the ancient
Aramaic saying
"Maranatha!"

To the very end, the book of Revelation has emphasized readiness and watchfulness.

Verse 21

The grace (charis = undeserved favor) of the Lord Jesus be with God's people.

Amen.

Both this book and the Bible as a whole end with a word of grace. Even despite the amount of destruction described in Revelation – it is at it's core a book of hope and grace with a heavy dose of watchfulness!
