Knowledge and Experience Requirements

- Bachelor's degree in pastoral ministries or equivalent from accredited evangelical institution.
- Heart to equip families for Christ-centered living.
- Demonstrates Biblical qualifications for pastoral ministry (Timothy 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9).
- Excellent communication skills including current social media platforms.
- Experience in event planning and leading special events.
- Experience in team building and leadership.
- Ability to evaluate kids and youth ministry curricula.
- Three to five year commitment to Sierra Bible Church.
- Called by the Lord to full-time ministry.

Areas of Responsibility

Youth and Kids Ministries will aim to demonstrate a Christ-centered life to families of Sierra Bible Church. The Pastor of Youth and Kids Ministries will oversee the culture, structures, and atmosphere of our discipleship and outreach ministries:

Sierra Kids—cradle through elementary school, and

Sierra Youth—middle school and high school. He will:

- Connect regularly with parents to provide a clear partnership in the discipling of their children.
- Work closely with leaders of Sierra Kids and Sierra Youth to ensure that parents are equipped to lead their children and that young people have spiritual mentors.
- Collaborate with the Pastoral Team to ensure that there are opportunities for all generations to worship, learn, and serve together.

Oversight of Sierra Kids:

- Oversee the Sunday Kids' ministry team including teachers, helpers, and curriculum implementation.
- Teach and lead The King's Academy Chapel and His Kids' Preschool weekly devotions.
- Connect AWANA, The King's Academy, and His Kids' Preschool to Sierra Bible Church discipleship.

Oversight of Sierra Youth:

- Teach, recruit, train, and lead Sierra Youth, including weekly student ministry gatherings.
- Oversee and minister to volunteer leaders, including parents, students and others.
- Organize discipleship and outreach special events.
