



Gladys Batiste Scholarship Application Olivet Baptist Church

Gladys Batiste was a dedicated member of Olivet Baptist Church who worked in all capacities when asked by church members or her Pastor. When Sister Batiste parted this life, she wanted a scholarship fund set up in her honor. This scholarship program is designed to assist Christian High School graduates financially to attend Colleges, Universities and other Institutions of Higher Learning.

High School Seniors must meet the following criteria to be considered for scholarship:

1. The scholarship applicant must be an active member of Oliver Baptist Church.
2. Must participate in some church activities.
3. Must be a high school senior graduating in the fall, spring or summer of your senior year.
4. **Have a grade point average of 2.50 graduating from high school.**
5. Plan to attend an Institution of Higher Learning.
6. Submit a typed written essay with title included of 250-300 words.
7. Submit a Resume'
8. Submit two letters of recommendation to include date and signatures.

Eligibility Requirements; if you are awarded the Gladys Batiste Scholarship:

- A. Submit a copy your college admissions letter to the scholarship committee.
- B. You must enrolled in a minimum of six (6) hours or more of classes by January 31, 2022.
- C. **Submit an official sealed copy of transcript, and submit a copy of class schedule to reflect minimum of six hours or more for each semester.**
- D. As a **freshman** in college you must maintain a **2.50 GRADE POINT AVERAGE OR HIGHER**, as a **sophomore, junior** and **senior**, you must maintain a **2.75 GRADE POINT AVERAGE OR HIGHER**. **Failure to maintain the minimum requirement, will result in the loss of your scholarship. However, in order to be reinstated, the recipient must earn a 2.75 at the end of the following semester to be considered for an award for the next semester. If the applicant is still interested in receiving the scholarship for the next school year after that semester, he or she must meet with the scholarship committee for review.**

DEADLINE: The required application to include essay, resume and two letters of recommendation must be postmarked no later than January 31, 2021. **Documents received after the due date will not be reviewed by the scholarship committee.** For additional information contact Wanda K.
