*Dear Friends and Partners,*

As I sit writing this letter, it is raining outside: a cold front has come in, our summer is over, those long hot days are behind us: fall season is just ahead. A change has occurred, certainly not unusual, it happens every year. I am reminded that the last of the milo harvest is coming to a close, the fields are being laid up and farmers are preparing for next year.

As I think on this change of season, I am reminded of a quote by Billy Graham; *"The evangelist harvest is always urgent...we are not responsible for the past generation, and we cannot bear full responsibility for the next one. However we do have our generation! God will hold us responsible at the Judgment Seat of Christ for how well we fulfilled our responsibilities and took full advantage of our opportunities."*

- Earlier this year we sent a team into Wales, the team was used mightily by the Lord, and a return trip is being planned for 2015
- In June a team ministered in the Northern region of the Philippines

- A team is traveling next to Nepal; by mid-November they will be there ministering in the country
- At the end of November, Papa's House will be in Southern region of Mindanao, Philippines
- At the beginning of December Papa's house will be ministering in Korea
